### Summary Notes and Action Items:

The meeting was called to order at 1:05 pm EDT.

Action Items from the February 22nd meeting were reviewed. All had been completed.

Don Woodward reported that there have been five withdrawals and there are still 15 papers missing of the 132 Oral Presentations scheduled. This Friday, March 26th will be the final opportunity for oral presenters to get their papers in. After that they will be moved to the poster session and their spots in the oral program will be filled with poster presenters who have submitted papers. Speakers who have not submitted their papers have been reminded to that effect.

Presently there are 11 Demonstrations and 22 Posters in the FIHMC portion of the program. Exhibits are being handled by Joe Treadway and are predominantly sedimentation oriented.

All sessions have assigned moderators and most have been assigned co-moderators. Jerry Bernard is handling this task and has produced a working list which, due to potential changes, has not been posted on the website.

**Action:** Don Frevert will forward the working list of moderators and co-moderators to Jeff Harris. Anyone else on the work group who would like to see it should let Don know. The working list is for internal use only at this time.

Obey reported that preparations are on schedule for the short courses.

Jeff Rieker reported that the conference registration website is open and operating. Most short courses have at least two and some have as many as five participants already registered. A total of 88 people have registered so far - 61 of them as fully paying conference participants. Registration activity is likely to peak on or about the deadline for the early registration discount.

**Action:** Jeff Rieker will send Obey periodic updates on registration for the various short courses.

Don Frevert reported that efforts are continuing to secure funding from the National Science Foundation (NSF) to support student participation. Doug Glysson has committed to provide the necessary student support if NSF does not provide the necessary funding.

Jeff Harris reported that he is aware of 26 students who plan to attend the conference. Nine of these have expressed a need for financial support and 13 have expressed a willingness to serve as Audio Visual assistants.
