

Action Items from ACWI 2009 Meeting

1. The Methods and Data Comparability Board will proceed with adding physical habitat data elements to the Water Quality Data Elements Users' Guide, per the [resolution](#) that was adopted by ACWI at the February 2009 meeting.
2. Based on ACWI's approval of a [resolution](#) presented by the Subcommittee on Ground Water (SOGW) at the February 2009 meeting, ACWI will:
 - Make the SOGW Framework Document (as revised) available to the Department of the Interior, the Office of Management and Budget, the Council on Environmental Quality, the Office of Science and Technology Policy, and the ACWI member organizations.
3. Based on ACWI's approval of a [resolution](#) presented by the Subcommittee on Ground Water (SOGW) at the February 2009 meeting, SOGW will:
 - Move forward with development and initiation of pilot testing based on the conceptual implementation plan for the National Ground Water Monitoring Network as presented in the Framework Document (with modifications based upon comments received from ACWI and other stakeholders).
 - Continue three of the four Working Groups within the SOGW (Inventory, Field Practices, and Data Standards and Data Management), and reorganize the fourth Working Group (Design) into a Implementation Working Group.
4. The National Water Quality Monitoring Council will revise their resolution on the National Monitoring Network and re-present it to ACWI at a later date, as appropriate.
