Summary Notes and Action Items:

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm EDT.

Action Items from the March 22nd meeting were reviewed. All had been completed.

Don Woodward reported that the technical program is about to be finalized. Abstracts were due to Francisco Simoes on April 15th and nearly all have been submitted. Moderators are lined up for all sessions and all but a few have co-moderators.

There are still about 11 demonstrations and 22 posters in the FIHMC portion of the program. Exhibits are being handled by Joe Treadway and are predominantly sedimentation oriented.

Paula reported numbers for the five FIHMC short courses - two each in the Curve Number and EXCEL-Lent short courses, one in the HEC short course and none so far in the RiverWare and CWAT classes. A total of 159 participants have registered for the conference so far. It is hoped that the short course numbers and the total conference registration numbers will pick up as the early registration deadline approaches. Short course instructors can save money by bringing their own projectors. A total of 31 people have signed up for the four day Grand Canyon field trip prior to the conference.

Power Point presentations need to be uploaded on the conference website - www.jfic.us on or before May 31st. There are about 14 volunteers for AV Assistant Positions and Jeff Harris is looking for more.

Pete Hawkins reported that the University of Arizona has received funding from the National Science Foundation (NSF) to support student participation. Ultimately about \$18,000 is expected to be available. Pete will be contacting those students who have asked for support and asking them to formally submit their requests. Cassie Klumpp has been seeking speakers for the student luncheon. Cassie, Don Woodward, Don Frevert,

Dave Goodrich and Jeff Harris will assist Pete on judging in the student paper and poster competition.

A reminder will be sent to all registrants to sign up for the Jubilee backstage tour. Room reservations should be made through the conference website.

The work group is still seeking a chair and vice chair for 2010 to 2014. The term will start in October. Anyone interested should contact Don Frevert.

In lieu of another conference call it was decided the group would join in on the JFIC wide conference call that Doug Glysson and Paula Makar are organizing. This call will be held during the week of May 10th to 14th.
