**EPA's Water Contaminant Information Tool (WCiT)** is a secure database of the most current information on priority contaminants for drinking water and wastewater security. It contains data that will assist in planning for and responding to drinking water contamination threats and incidents. As a planning tool, WCiT is meant to support vulnerability assessments, emergency response plans, and site-specific response guidelines. As a response tool, WCiT is designed to provide real-time information on water contaminants to inform response decisions.

The WCiT webinar will be a live demonstration of the WCiT web tool.
