With funding from the National Science Foundation, The Consortium of Universities for the Advancement of Hydrologic Science, inc. (CUAHSI) has developed a "services-oriented architecture" for sharing water data called the CUAHSI Hydrologic Information System (HIS) that works much like the web works. CUAHSI HIS currently catalogs about 100 different data sources, including the USGS, EPA, some state agencies and many universities. These sources account for millions of sites and literally billions of data values that can be discovered and downloaded in a consistent format using client software that integrates a GIS into a data analysis tool. CUAHSI HIS is eager to work with more data providers to include them in CUAHSI HIS.
