Decades ago, the Urban Drainage and Flood Control District had the foresight to purchase land along all major stream channels through the Denver and Boulder metropolitan areas to prevent urban development in the floodplain. As part of this plan, a wonderful trail system now exists for pedestrians and bicyclist. We will make use of this trail system to visit several channel restoration sites that are designed to convey floods, provide habitat, and enable recreation use.
