The Workgroup was formed in 2009 and published the *National Action Plan: Priorities for Managing Freshwater Resources in a Changing Climate* in 2011.

Much progress has been made in the climate change adaptation arena since 2011, including implementation of many of the specific actions outlined in the *National Action Plan*. The Workgroup is now evaluating priority actions for the coming years and is seeking early public input.
